

Project 1: Taxonomy Creation for Mutual Funds

- Identify the scope of requirements
- Review all the reference material (Local Standards and Acts)
- Analyzing mutual funds reports and financial statements
- Conceptual design & data modeling
- Taxonomy Creation, Test & Review
 - Defining the XBRL properties of the elements finalized
 - Build Taxonomy
 - Validate XBRL correctness using taxonomy validators







XBRL Implementation Approaches

- Deeply embedded approach
- Bolt-on XBRL software package
 - Implementation Time
 - Control
 - Cost
 - Complexity Level
 - The level of necessary knowledge







XBRL Implementation Approaches


- Deeply embedded approach
 - Change current process
 - Difficult to Estimate Cost
 - Implementation Time
- Bolt-on XBRL software package
 - Facilitates mapping of mutual funds data with the taxonomy
 - No need to change current process
 - Fastest And low cost solution







XBRL based Disclosure System for Mutual Funds



Projects2:Design & Develop XBRL based Disclosure Software Platform for Mutual Funds

- The platform to enable SEO to publish all mutual funds reports in a single window
- Data reported by mutual funds will be validated against the XBRL Taxonomy and business rules
- Users will be able to view and download mutual funds financial data & repots in XBRL format for analysis
