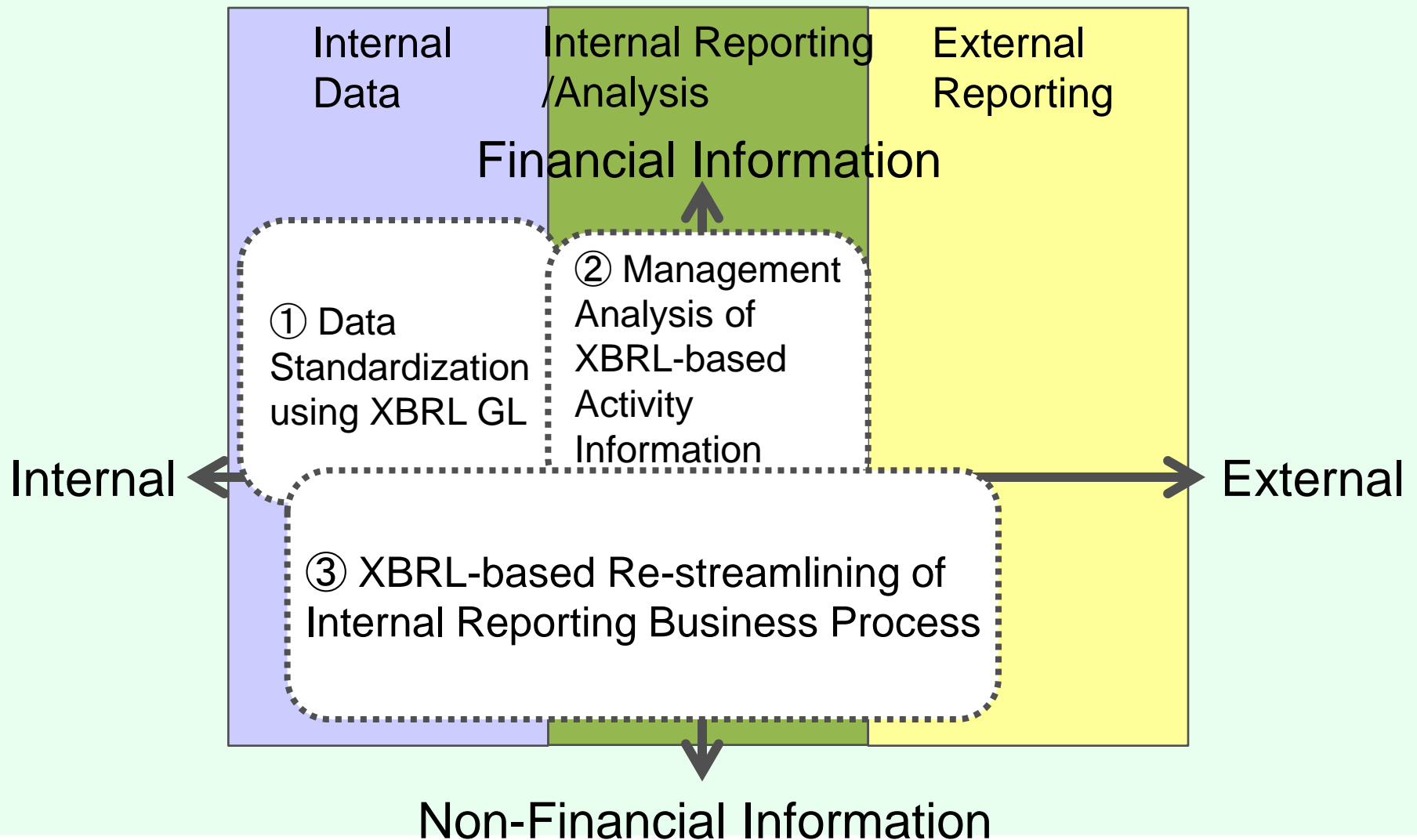

Situation : Each department in HQ independently communicates and gathers reports from subsidiaries using email and MS-Excel, resulting in inefficient business process for both HQ and subsidiaries.

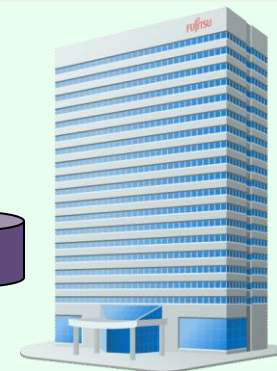
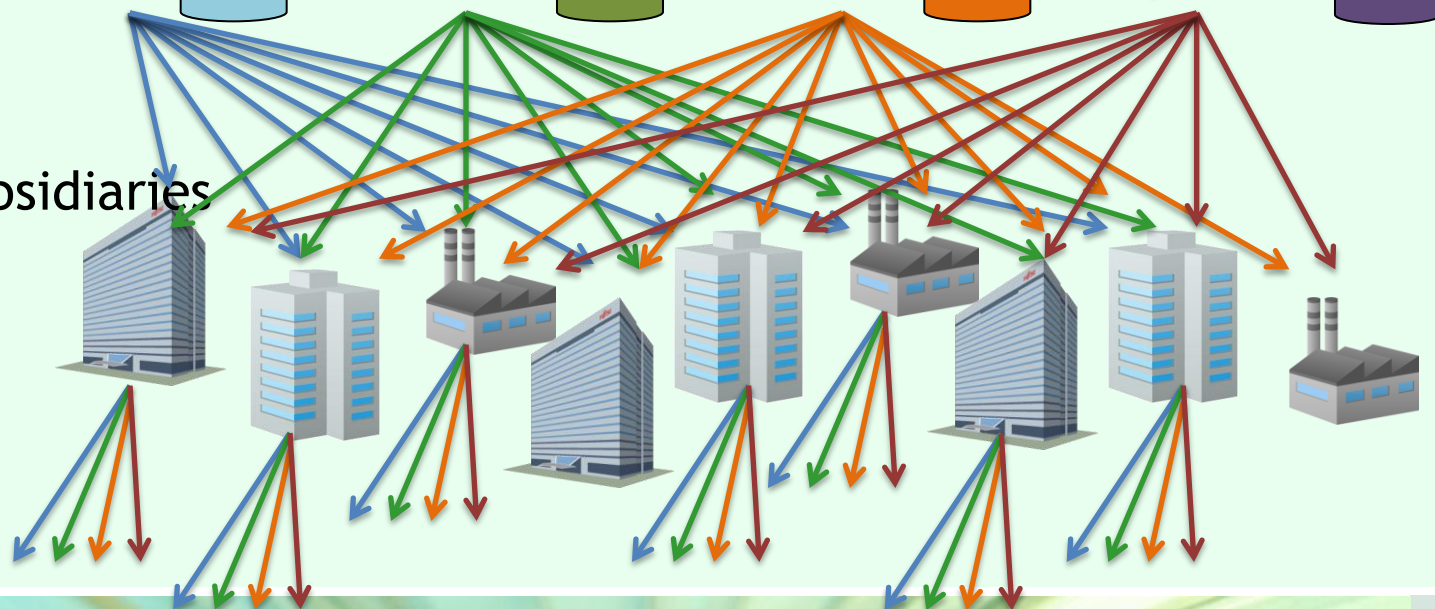

Issues around Internal Reporting

Pain Points

- ✓ Redundant reporting work at subsidiaries side
- ✓ HQ needs to make cumbersome confirmation of PIC in subsidiaries
- ✓ HQ has no business process monitoring and management at subsidiaries
- ✓ Inconsistent reporting, erroneous reporting from subsidiaries
- ✓ No data sharing environment at HQ

- ✓ Design Consolidated Data Model for internal reporting
- ✓ Design Unified Reporting Process
